From the desk of Deacon Brenda

Christ is Risen! He is Risen indeed! Alleluia!

I once worked with a pastor who stopped everyone on Easter to see if they would respond appropriately to the prompt "Christ is Risen!" with "He is risen indeed, Alleluia!." If we forgot one word, or didn't say it with energy and a fair amount of VOLUME, he would make us practice it until we got it right. He had a deep passion for people and Jesus, and would remind us that even if we didn't feel like responding to his cue, we had to finish the phrase. I later learned this ancient Orthodox greeting is an act of unity around the belief in Christ's resurrection. Jesus' life, death and resurrection happened with people around him. They too had to tell each other of this most remarkable news - God, who came to earth in flesh and blood, lived and died and the third day he rose again.

I thought about that the other day because I was talking with my friend who always reminds me that we need to live our lives in response to this amazing news that "Christ is Risen!" But on days when it seems nothing is going right, my attitude is much more this: 'christ is risen' or "Christ is risen?" or even christ is risen. Those are the days I need people in my life - I need my community of people, I need my church - my fellow followers of Jesus around me.


