Greetings Big Grove Crow River Grace Parish,

Happy New Year!

The first Sunday in January we will be celebrating Baptism of Our Lord. This is a Sunday in which we remember Jesus' baptism as well as our own baptisms.

In past newsletter articles, I have shared devotions from one of my favorite devotional books, which is by Henri Nouwen and called, "*You are the Beloved: Daily Meditations for Spiritual Living*". The devotion that I am sharing with you this month is from Henri's book, *Beyond the Mirror*. It is the devotion for January 2nd and speaks about Jesus' baptism and anchoring yourself in God's love.

Anchor Yourself in God's Love

"When Jesus was baptized in the Jordan, he heard a voice from heaven saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:17). These words revealed the true identity of Jesus as the beloved. Jesus truly heard that voice, and all of his thoughts, words, and actions came forth from his deep knowledge that he was infinitely loved by God. Jesus lived his life from that inner place of love. Although human rejections, jealousies, resentments, and hatred did hurt him deeply, he remained anchored in the love of the Father. At the end of his life, he said to his disciples, "Listen: the time will come – indeed has come already – when you are going to be scattered, each going his own way and leaving me alone. And yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me" (John 16:32)."

- Pastors Report: 19 kids went Christmas shopping; there is a
 Christmas giving tree at Grace; the Free Spirit turkey dinner went
 well; preschoolers will be getting preschool bibles in December and
 January; fees for Green lake Bible camp are changing and there are
 discounts for early registration; 10 kids signed up for Montana trip
 and 1 for the New Orleans youth gathering; the Women's retreat had
 8 from our parish attend; FCS breakfasts average 15 kids a week;
