From a young age, Thomas was highly intelligent and ambitious. He became a school teacher when he was 16 years old and an associate editor for his hometown newspaper when he was 21. When he was 27 years old, he began to follow Christ and from then on used his abilities and ambitions for God.

He became a Methodist minister and served a congregation in Scottsville, Kentucky. Due to health problems, Thomas had to leave the congregation he was serving. His health problems created financial issues for him and his family. Many would have become bitter due to losing their profession and having great financial difficulties, yet for Thomas he turned the opposite way and chose to see God's faithfulness in all that he did. It was in 1923 that he wrote this poem, which later turned into the hymn we know as "Great is Thy Faithfulness".

> All I have needed Thy hand hath provided Great is Thy faithfulness, Lord, unto me

God has been faithful in the past, is faithful in the present and will continue to be faithful till the end of the age.
